

# NOGEYAMA ZOO

There are over 1,000 animals in this zoo. The range of animals is extensive; from polar regions to equatorial jungles and grasslands (lions, zebras, giraffes). Some nocturnal animals can be observed in their houses (night monkeys, etc.). you may be amused by observations you make at the Mountain of Monkeys, just as the residents are amused by their observations of human beings. There are also about 130 different kinds of birds, including flamingoes, peacocks, eagles and ostriches.

## ☞ HOW TO GET THERE:

### From YOKOSUKA CHUO

Go to YOKOSUKA CHUO station and buy a ¥350 ticket for HINODE-CHO on KEIKYU Line. Go to track #2 and take a GREEN or RED KANJI train to KAMIOOKA. ► At KAMIOOKA station, change to a BLACK KANJI train waiting across the platform. Ride 5 stops to HINODE-CHO.

### From IEKGO

Go to JIMMUJI Station and buy a ¥300 ticket for HINODE-CHO on KEIKYU Line. Take a train from track #2 to KANAZAWA BUNNKO and change to a GREEN or RED KANJI train bound for YOKOHAMA, SHINAGAWA to KAMIOOKA. **Continue as above ►.**

It takes about 10 minutes from HINODE-CHO station to NOGEYAMA ZOO. After you exit from the station, follow the road to the left that goes up to the hill. You will soon come to another street that you will make a immediate left onto (you will pass by several small alleys on the way). Follow the road to the left after you see the first zoo map up the hill.
